Kinabatangan landscape

Forest cover & orangutan number 90% decline since 1980

Females live within 10s of hectares

Males wander far

Main limiting factor : food

Main threats : harm and “rescue”



What we aim to do



- **Stabilise & increase the resident orangutan population by :**
 - Sustain & restore female home ranges
 - Enrich landscape for males
 - Stop harm & orangutan translocations
 - Develop BMPs to minimize conflict & promote co-existence
